Pollinator

Bats are relied upon by over 500 species of plant for pollination (think bananas, mangoes and agarve for tequila!)



Insectivorous bats species can consume thousands of insects each night. Not only do they keep pesky insect populations regulatedbut can also act as crop protectors as they keep bugs away.

The Biodiversity Indicator
